*The cost of the Early Years Quality Standards is based on the size of the provision, number of children and the level of quality mark the setting chooses to work towards. Deadline for cohort applications is 20th July 2024.*

EYQS is organised into a 2-year cycle. You may choose to complete year 1 EYQS as a standalone award or complete both years of the award to achieve EYQS Premium. Your award expires 5 years after the date of your award. You can continue to add to your award for up to 5 years by completing EYQS modules each year.

The EYQS scheme is a practical and participatory approach that emphasises problem solving, collaboration, and positive change.



### YEAR 1 EYQS

The first year supports you to reflect on your statutory and core provision through a series of self-evaluative modules. You will undertake two statutory and two core modules before selecting from a range of subject specific modules. Your allocated mentor will visit you twice within this year to support you with your EYQS journey.



### YEAR 2 EYQS PREMIUM

The second year allows you to deepen your knowledge, understanding and practice by focusing on one area of provision where you determine the widest gaps are in your provision. This may have been highlighted during the year 1 process or may be identified from your cohort information.

It will take the form of a project which includes the whole team and will incorporate an audit from the Early Years Team. The audit will be specific to your chosen area for development. Following your audit your project will include your team undertaking research and using the result of your chosen audit scale alongside this research to improve outcomes.

Environment, interactions, equality and diversity, nature, safeguarding, outdoor provision, staff well being, working with babies, early literacy, working with families, communication & language, and more!
