Further information about the spelling rules listed in the content domain reference column, including the International Phonetic Alphabet can be found in the <u>Spelling Appendix</u> of the national curriculum.

The fourth column indicates further aspects of spelling of the target word that could be difficult for children. These aspects were not listed in the STA mark scheme.
